Knowledge of native plants and invasive weeds is a must, along with a sensitivity to heirloom plants that focus on the family history of the land from 1815 up to the 1980s. Giving direction to other gardeners and volunteers, as well as working with a team is vital to the position. Upholding a beautiful presentation of the grounds to the public is paramount.

The Head Gardener shall develop, periodically revise and implement the fiveyear plan for the gardens with the goal of creating and maintaining aesthetically pleasing gardens that reflect the historical practices of former owners of Rosedale during the 1815 – 1832 (Archibald Frew's time-period), 1870's – 1919 (Baxter Caldwell's time-period) (1914 – 1958 Craig and Louise Heagy Davidson's time-period).
